7 steps to fundraising

1. Choose a fundraising idea

Here are some ideas to get you started...

For the fitness gurus...A Fun Run

Have you always wanted to do a sponsored run, walk or cycle ride? Then this is your chance! You can participate in an event and ask your friends and family to sponsor you. A great way of keeping healthy and fit for a brilliant cause.

For the really organised...A School Fete

Do you think you could get everyone together and organise lots of stalls and games? Then a school fete is for you! Perfect for the summer months and fun for all the family.

For the math's whizzes...Collections

Collections are a great way of raising money. You can collect money at an existing event, like a concert or sale, or hold your own special event. Remember, you'll need a special licence if it takes place outside school (see Keep it Legal and Safe).

For the brainiacs...A Quiz Night

Have you always fancied hosting your own quiz show? You get to write the questions and decide who wins! You could organise a quiz as part of your school day, or invite your parents along and make it a family event.

For the chefs....A Cake Sale

Do you love cooking and eating? Then have a cake sale! Guaranteed to sell out and is a great way of getting everyone involved.

For the budding explorers...A Thai Day

Why don't you organise a sponsored Thai Day at your school? The Young Fundraisers' Club is a membership-only online club for our fundraisers. It is very easy to join. All you need to do is to sign on with a nickname (this is for your safety) and your email address so you can receive our regular newsletters.

You qualify for your Young Fundraisers Club badge and certificate.

Your teacher, youth leader or parent will need to apply for these for you. All they need to do is print out the form at the end of this pack, Click [to download](#) fill it in, and send it back to us with the cheque for the money you've raised (made payable to 'Pattaya Orphanage Trust'). It doesn't have to be a lot! The Young Fundraisers Club is all about getting involved and having a great time.

You'll also receive our special e-newsletter once a term. This will give you lots of updates on our work, tips on how to fundraise, and more games and cool stuff to download.

2 Make sure of success!

- Tell everyone! Send a group e mail
- Tell your local newspaper and/or radio station. You can use the news release

form at the end of the pack as a guide [click to download](#) and send it off. When you issue a press release please always send a copy by email to news@helphthaikids.org.uk. If you would like help with contacting the press, please contact us at yfc@helphthaikids.org.uk

- You can give out invitations, posters and flyers. Email yfc@helphthaikids.org.uk to request leaflets. Be sure to let us know where to send them, when they are required and how many you need.
- **Tell us what you're planning!** email yfc@helphthaikids.org.uk and we will put your event on our events page so that people know its official!
- Send us your ideas and photos, and see what other kids are planning!
- Advertise the event in your school, church, local library, swimming pool, or post office.

You must include these details:

Who are you? What are you doing? Who is taking part? When is it happening? Where it is happening? Why it is going to be so much fun! Why it is important?

Let people know its in aid of the Pattaya Orphanage Trust, and other young people will benefit from the funds you raise.

- **Tip - the total you raise can be bigger** if sponsors who work sign a Gift Aid declaration - and it doesn't cost them any extra. This is easier with sponsorship through JustGiving.

4. Whatever you are planning please remember

- Only get sponsored or collect money from those you know and trust. Ensure that you are supervised and don't collect from strangers!
- Make sure everyone coming or taking part in your event will be safe.
- Be safe about carrying money you have raised, give it to an adult
